When Should I Sanitize My Hands?

Is There A Particular Hand Sanitizer I Should Use?

Yes, be sure your hand sanitizer contains between 60% to 95% alcohol to be effective. Dial® Hand Sanitizer contains 62%.

How Do I Use Hand Sanitizer?

Apply hand sanitizer to dry hands. Rub hands together, wetting all surfaces of the hands and fingers until dry. Use enough so that your hands will remain wet for at least 15 seconds.

Can I Sanitize Instead Of Washing With Soap & Water?

Hand sanitizing does NOT replace hand washing! Alcohol kills germs but does not remove soils.
